# Minutes of the General Membership Meeting, February 11, 2020

Meeting Opened by President Scott Hudson at 7:03 PM

28 members present / Guest Royce Chambers introduced himself.

### **Reports:**

Eric Kirby read the General Meeting minutes from Jan. 14, 2020 which were accepted.

Eric also read the Board Meeting minutes from Jan. 23, 2020

### **Unfinished Business:**

1. Scott brought up the Events Calendar and asked us to give it some thought for later in the meeting
2. Scott presented the awards trophies to the recipients who were present

  - Broken Prop Award to Paul Starks
  - Member of the Year to Patty and Larry Myers
  - Modeler of the Year to Eric Kirby
3. Art Kelly gave us an Update on the present Pattern Flying situation and tells us that the "Rumble on the Rogue" trophy has returned to our club!  
Art urged any new interested flyers to give pattern flying a try, there are beginner & novice categories to enter and many experienced pilots in our club to give you help and advice.  
Art also urged all club members to make our voices heard to the FAA by the March 2nd deadline.  
Open discussion about the new FAA proposed ruling followed.
4. Sean Mersh explained the differences between NSRCA ( Pattern Flying ) and IMAC scale model pattern flying.  
Sean also pointed out that Art is the new District 8 VP for Oregon / Washington / Alaska / Idaho and Wyoming.
5. Scott tells us that the gate combo has now been changed and that the taxes have been done for 2019 Scott also reminds us that a new " How To Renew" tab under the Members tab has been set up.
6. Scott gave us an update on the runway crack situation and that we are waiting for an inspection from a company that Knife River recommended and an estimate for repairs.

1. Scott tells us that the field was recently sprayed by Greenway Spray that covered 8 acres.
2. Scott tells us that we received an "Club Recognition and Reward Grant" for \$175.- that Larry Cogdell organized. Larry read the "Thank You Letter" he received from the AMA. Larry also tells us that the Mall Show went up to \$250.- and this refund helps offset that cost. The club thanked Larry for his hard work.
3. Scott mentions that the access road dust control has been discussed with the county and has asked for it to be done again this year.
