Martin Waide showed us his "In the Bones" Brooks biplane with a Saito 4S / 40 engine. This was from a free flight design that he modified to strip ailerons. He plans on covering it with silk and dope.

Dave Norton brought his "Debolt" in the bones airplane which originally was a 1952 free flight design.

He remembers his dad giving him a kit of the same plane when he was a kid around 1956. He's planning an OS 10 engine for power.

Larry Miller showed us his "Das Little Stick" converted to tail dragger, covered in red and using 4 cell electric power. Weight about 4 lbs.




