Minutes of the General Membership Meeting, Aug. 13, 2019

Pres. Scott Hudson opened the meeting at 7:00 PM.

Reports:

Eric Kirby read the GM club minutes from July 9 also the Board Minutes from July 25.

Unfinished Business:

3. Airshow Update.

Brothers Excavation came out and helped clean up the field with some of their equipment.

Paar Lumber generously donated T-Shirts and hats and power tools.

Clean up day is set for Sat. Aug. 17th.

Larry reminds us that he needs ice donations for the coolers.

Larry tells us that he will be on location from Tuesday onwards the week before the show.

We still need volunteers to help out with the parking areas, flightline and gate.

4. Scott tells us that Ben and Sue Musolf have volunteered to run the food booth.

5. Scott tells us that the two 5 Gal. gas cans have seals that are disintegrating.

A motion was made to purchase two new cans, was seconded and passed.

6. Larry Cogdell asked about advertising banners to hang on the control line fencing and would like to get permission to hang one up for his business.

Larry was also generous enough to match a \$ 500.- Paar Lumber donation to the Airshow!

New Business:

1. Larry Cogdell gave us a report on the Aviation Day / Mall Show on Aug. 10

4. Jay Strickland gave us the Leader Minutes with an update on fixed wing flying sites and
info. on class G airspace regulations.

flying site. The club appreciates everybody's interest and motivation to help improve
the facility but we ask that additions and improvements be first run by the board for approval.
