Open:

Unfinished Business:

Larry would like to see promotion for the event begin earlier, March or April, along with raffle ticket sales at the same time.

The Children's Miracle Network will receive approximately \$2,700 in donations directly because of the club airshow.

Total club income from the event is unknown at this time since bills and income are still being processed. Probably only slightly better than break even.

Bruce Tharpe reported on the Vintage R/C event. Good turnout in spite of the smoky conditions. One attendee flew a private plane from California to be here.

Art Kelly updated the group on the upcoming Pattern Contest. He also discussed the workshop/seminar held last weekend to introduce beginners to pattern flying. He was happily surprised at the larger than anticipated turn out.

Richard Schwegerl expressed displeasure at the starting stand orientation voted on at the last meeting. Clark Wolf made a motion to discuss the starting stand orientation at the next membership meeting after informing the membership of the discussion via REACT and meeting minutes. Seconded, discussed. 9 for, 11 against.

It was then suggested that improvements to the existing starting stand orientation be investigated in hopes that additional modifications would eliminate the objections to the current orientation while still maintaining the current orientation advantages.

Richard made a motion to recognize Roger Hebner's contributions to the club by awarding him a Life Membership. Seconded, discussed, passed.
